

Whitby's Dylan Creaney off to Junior Pan Ams for karate

WHITBY -- The ICKF karate school in Whitby continues to churn out impressive results.

Dylan Creaney has been selected by Karate Canada, the national sport organization, to be a member of the national junior team that will compete at the 2014 Junior Pan American karate championships in Lima, Peru from Aug. 25 to Sept. 1.

This will be Creaney's sixth time representing Canada in international competition. He has four international bronze medals, won at the North American Cup, U.S. Open, U.S. Junior Olympics and Commonwealth championships.

Creaney, who has been training at ICKF Karate school since he was eight, also competed at last year's Junior Pan Ams in Columbia. He will be competing against the top two karate athletes from each nation in the under-84kg category for 18-20 year olds.

Cameron Martin, Megan Sorichetti and Kaitlyn Morrish all recently competed at the Ontario Summer Games at the University of Windsor. The three were selected by Karate Ontario based on their results in the provincial grand prix tournament circuit, and competed in the 14-15 plus-54kg category.

Morrish took the silver medal and Sorichetti the bronze, with Martin just missing the podium in fourth.
